ALLEGED COMPLAINT

Any person desiring to report misconduct or improper job performance by a police employee will be first directed to the employee's immediate supervisor. The supervisor will meet with you to initially discuss your complaint. Sometimes issues can be resolved at this point by the supervisor, who may be able to answer your questions and concerns. The supervisor will assist you with completing the complaint form if you feel your concerns were not answered to your satisfaction. Your complaint will then be forwarded to the Chief of Police.

The Chief of Police will review your complaint and order an investigation into your complaint. An investigator will be assigned to fully investigate your complaint. The investigator will contact you and request an interview with you. The investigator will gather all facts and evidence and prepare a report for the Chief of Police. Each allegation of misconduct is examined on its own merits in an objective manner.

The Chief of Police will review the investigation and render a finding. Within 30 days of the Chief's finding, you will be notified in writing of the finding. To comply with State law, the police department retains personnel complaints for a period of five (5) years.
